## ASB

**The Austin Symphonic Band** is a wind and percussion instrument ensemble composed of 90-plus Austin area musicians dedicated to the artistic performance of a variety of music. Members represent the full spectrum of Austin area citizenry with backgrounds as diverse as the community – doctors, lawyers, white collar and blue collar workers, executives, nurses, teachers, and students. Some thrive on the recognition of performing. Others find playing music a healthy outlet from stressful jobs. The common bond is music.

The Band is dedicated to the public performance of band literature, and offers several public and community service concerts each year.

In addition to its Austin area performance schedule, the Band has appeared at the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago, the Texas Bandmasters Association Convention in San Antonio, the Texas Music Educators Association Convention in San Antonio, the American Bandmasters Association Convention in New Orleans, the Northwest International Band Clinic in Seattle, and the Association of Concert Bands Convention in Richardson. It has appeared in productions of the Austin Lyric Opera and Broadway Austin, and regularly provides music for Bastrop and Round Rock as part of their July patriotic festivals. ASB is a recipient of the Sudler Scroll, given by the John Philip Sousa Foundation, and carries the designation of Official Band of the City of Austin.

**ASB Music Director Richard Floyd** is Texas State Director of Music Emeritus. He has served as Musical Director and Conductor of the Austin Symphonic Band since 1985. Mr Floyd is a recognized authority on conducting, the art of wind band rehearsing, concert band repertoire, and music advocacy.

**Assistant Director Bill Haehnel** has been a Texas music educator for 31 years. Mr Haehnel has served on the music faculty at The University of Texas in Austin and instructor of percussion at Texas Lutheran University in Seguin.

**Guest Conductor Cheryl Floyd** is Director of Bands at Hill Country Middle School in Westlake. Ms Floyd maintains a keen interest in commissioning new works for concert band and her programs are nationally known for the works produced as a result of these commissions. *Cajun Folk Songs*, conducted by Ms Floyd tonight, was commissioned by the Murchison Middle School Band during Ms Floyd's tenure there.
